



Jesus as a Boy

Suggestions for the Teacher

Lead-In

Show the picture to the children. Discuss with them what they see. Ask what she/he may feel.... Let the children play the story in a role-play. Instruct them before.

Provide disguise / fancy dress and additional materials like a scroll (Bible)...

Lesson Instructions

Begin telling the story...

Discuss with the children...

- Have you ever been separated from your parents? How do you think they may have felt? (They experienced worry.)
- Why is Jesus in the temple? (He seeks a close connection to His heavenly Father.)
- What does Jesus do in the temple?
 (He speaks with the scribes and teachers. He asks questions and gives answers.)
- Why does Jesus know so much about God? (Because God is His Father)

Have the children repeat...

- As a young boy, Jesus listened to Israel's teachers.
- Jesus was willing to learn about God.
- It is important for us to come into God's house.

Real-Life Application (explain the following)

- Jesus realized, even as a twelve-year-old boy that He had a special task here on earth.
- Our task on earth is to be prepared for the return of Jesus.
- Therefore, it is important and necessary to listen to the word of God.
