Suggestions for the Teacher

Lead-In

Let a child do a morning prayer.

What should we pray for each day? (Angel's protection, parents, His return)

Lesson Instructions Begin telling the story...

Discuss with the children...

- What do we need to do to prepare for Jesus' return? (Be baptised with water and Holy Spirit, believe in Jesus, live our lives according to Jesus' teaching, strive to be like Jesus.)
- What did Jesus explain to His disciples on the Mount of Olives? (He would have to leave the earth and He would return.
 All nations on earth shall hear the glad tidings of God's love and mercy.)

Have the children repeat...

- Jesus told His disciples that He would return.
- We need to prepare ourselves for Jesus' return.
- We pay attention to what is said in the divine services and in Sunday School.
- We try to act accordingly.

Real-Life Application (explain the following)

- Jesus wants us to be with Him.
- We will be with Him on the day He returns.
- When does Jesus return?
 (He told his disciples that nobody knows the exact day and hour of His return.)
- Only God knows. That is why we have to remain watchful and prepared.
